



## EV Winter Prep Checklist: 10 Must-Do Steps Before Snow Season

### Check Your Tyres and Pressure

Use winter tyres, maintain proper pressure, and carry a portable digital inflator.

### Schedule Smart Charging

Finish charging just before departure to keep the battery warm.

### Preheat While Plugged In

Preheat the cabin and battery while plugged in to save range and time.

### Inspect and Clean Charging Ports

Wipe snow and salt, use silicone-safe contact spray, and protect with port caps.

### Protect Cables and Connectors

Store cables in weatherproof bags and use cold-rated cables when possible.

### Upgrade Cabin Comfort

Use heated seat covers and steering wheel heaters instead of full HVAC.

### Maintain Battery State of Charge

Keep charge between 20%–80%, plug in overnight in freezing weather.

### Prepare for slush and salt

Use all-weather mats and rubber trunk liners to protect your interior.

### Carry a Winter Essentials Kit

Include inflator, de-icer, scraper, power bank, and portable charger.

### Plan your Winter Routes

Use ABRP or PlugShare to locate reliable chargers under shelter.
